### 5-year cemetery safety audit

#### Inspection

Jon Abbott, Richard Higgins, Phil Roberts and David Stone inspected each memorial in Binegar Cemetery and Holy Trinity Churchyard on 2 June 2018. No members of the public attended.

#### Results

Two headstones in the cemetery require immediate action to make them safe.

Grave	Name	Issue
93	Gertrude Reynolds	Both memorials fail hand tests and risk falling to the ground if pushed
185	Douglas Hill	

Seven other cemetery headstones pose no immediate danger to the public but are not fully stable and so will need annual monitoring to assess any further deterioration.

Grave	Name	Issue
75	Lilian Wareham	Rocks but ground anchor prevents it falling
79	Edith Mears	Rocks but ground anchor prevents it falling
130	Nora Bianco	Leans forward
142	Owen McGinley	Rocks but ground anchor prevents it falling
146	Leslie Lyons	Rocks on unstable foundation stone
150	Denis Tucker	Leans forward
178	Desmond Evans	Rocks but ground anchor prevents it falling

Similarly, four memorials in Holy Trinity Churchyard will require annual monitoring.
