### Annual cemetery safety audit 2019 (year 1)

#### Inspection

The 2018 five-year inspection listed memorials that required action or monitoring. Richard Higgins and James Shanahan inspected those memorials in Binegar Cemetery and Holy Trinity Churchyard on 19 August 2019.

#### Results

Two memorials in the cemetery require immediate action to make them safe.

Grave	Name	Issue
93	Gertrude Reynolds	Fails hand test, risks falling. Temporarily secured in 2018. Work then ordered not executed.
75	Lilian Wareham	Headstone revolves on ground anchor. Joints to be secured. Family-owned. Owner not known.

Five headstones pose no immediate danger to the public but are not fully stable and will need annual monitoring to assess any further deterioration. General condition: no change.
