The Parish Council considered this application on 2 February 2016 and reached the following decision:

General observations

This site formally lies in Ashwick Parish but affects Gurney Slade and is close to Binegar Parish boundary.

The trees are part of Meadwood Tree Preservation Order Group.

The Council noted that, in 2012, the District Council granted permission to reduce the crowns of one beech and one ash by 30%. In 2014, it granted permission for felling one beech and two ash.

Meadwood is an important backdrop to views from Binegar Lane. IF granted, the current application would see 5 mature trees felled in two years.

Binegar Parish Council wish the Tree Conservation Officer to be content that the felling of two further ash will not compromise the Meadwood group and that he is content that the reasons for felling are valid.
